Day 1: Read or watch the book **“Man on the Moon.”**

Sit with an adult and **retell the story** in your own words. Use each page of the book to help you.




Day 4: Look at the pages showing the aliens. **Write down** or **tell your adult** some sentences to describe them. For example: **“They are green with three eyes and cheeky faces.”**



Day 2: Look at the picture of Bob’s living room. **Make a list** of all the things in the room that are to do with space.



Day 5: Design and draw an alien that you might find on the moon. **Add labels** to explain your design. Can you add some sentences to describe your alien?



Day 3: Read or watch the story again. Pay careful attention to all the events. Next, **draw a story map** of Bob’s day.



Day 6: Imagine that you are a moon tourist. **Write about** what you did on the moon. Use **sequencing words** such as ‘First’, ‘Next’, ‘Then’ and ‘After that’. **“First, I explored some deep craters.”**
