


Mission 4: Mr Big by Ed Vere

Day 1: Read or watch the book "Mr Big."

Sit with an adult and **retell the story** in your own words. Use each page of the book to help you.

Day 2: Make a list of as many words as you can think of that mean **SAD**. Now do the same for **HAPPY**.

Next, pretend you are Mr Big. Tell your adult how you feel at the **beginning** and at the **end** of the story. Can you use 'because' to explain why?

Day 3: Write words or sentences to **describe** Mr Big. What does he look like? What is he wearing? 'He is huge and hairy with a smart, stripy jacket.' 'He has round, white eyes and a tall, black hat.'

Can you try to use a **simile**? 'His eyes are as round as'

Day 4: Click the link and watch a video of **Ed Vere drawing** Mr Big.

Draw with Ed Vere: Mr Big

Now have a go at drawing him yourself! Can you draw him at the **beginning** and at the **end** of the story?

Day 5: Draw two **thought bubbles** and write what Mr Big is thinking at the **beginning** and **end** of the story.



Day 6: Write a **letter** to Mr Big to invite him to play the piano at your school. Make sure you:

- Use '**Dear**' at the beginning
- Tell Mr Big **who you are**
- Ask Mr Big a **question**
- Give Mr Big a **reason** you would like him to play at your school
- Use '**from**' or '**yours** **sincerely**' at the end
